**To: All former employees of Azure Publishing Inc. ("Azure" or the "Company").**

On December 16, 2025, Azure Publishing Inc. was deemed to have filed an Assignment in Bankruptcy. Dodick Landau Inc. was appointed as the Trustee in Bankruptcy ("Trustee") under Estate #31-3270451.

Former employees of the Company may be eligible to make a claim (the "Claim") which may be eligible for funding under the Wage Earner Protection Program Act (the "WEPPA"), a federal government program offered by Service Canada.

To apply for WEPPA funding, you must first submit a completed proof of claim form to the Trustee (blank copy will be found in the Creditor Package). **The proof of claim must be accepted by the Trustee prior to you filing a WEPPA application.**

To complete your Proof of Claim, please follow the following instructions:

- The Proof of Claim form is Form 31 and is attached to the Creditor Package.
- At the top right hand corner, please write your Social Insurance Number. This is required to file a Weppa claim through Service Canada. We cannot file your claim with Weppa without this information.
- Complete page one of the Proof of Claim. This is simply filling in the blanks, name, address, telephone number etc. **Your email address is very important in the Weppa process, therefore, please write it clearly and legibly.**
- At #1 write in your relationship to Azure. In most cases ex-employee is fine.
- At #3 write in the total amount of your claim. Please refer to the Schedule "A", - attached to this email.

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- At #5, That payment for this debt by the debtor to the creditor has been due (or has been in default) since the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2025. This would be your last day of work. If you are not sure of the date, an approximation is fine for this purpose. Do not fill in anything else in #5, this is sufficient.
- At #6A check the box that says **A. Unsecured Claim**\_\_\_\_\_ - on this line you will enter the amount as noted on the Schedule "A". This is the amount that is calculated to be termination pay. It could also be a portion of the outstanding wages. We have provided the total for this entry in the Schedule "A" attached.
- At #6 E, **Claim by Wage Earner** – please refer to the Schedule "A" for this amount.
- At #7 on page three confirm that you are not related to Azure Publishing Inc. in any way. Simply circle is not and has not if you are not related. If you say you are, we will contact you for further information.
- At #8, if you received any payments from the company with regard to the amount outstanding, please list the date and amount.
- At #9 – simply skip over this, this does not apply to a corporate bankruptcy.

- Be sure to sign the Proof of Claim form below the date.

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After our review of your Proof of Claim, if all matters are acceptable we will file with Weppa giving them confirmation of your claim. When this is complete we will send you an email confirming what we have processed and provide a copy of the submission. We will give you instructions on finalizing your claim with Weppa directly.

The deadline to apply for a WEPPA payment online or by mail is February 10, 2026, 56 days from the date of bankruptcy (December 16, 2025). If you are not able to submit your application on time, you are required to provide a reason in the WEPPA application form in order for the WEPPA application to be considered.

Please note that you are not entitled to make an application under the WEPPA if: (i) you have a controlling interest in the Company (a "Shareholder"), (ii) you occupied some managerial positions with the Company (a "Manager"); or (iii) you did not deal at arm's length with either the Shareholder or Manager.
